- Artist is responsible for creating, delivering, setting up, maintaining the Avenue Art within dates provided below.
- Awards will be provided for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place to be judged by Holland Area Arts Council representative and will be based on originality, creativity, use of medium, incorporation of theme and unique design.

- 3. The content displayed on each structure must remain neutral: no controversial material (nothing obscene or violent), no political or religious material, no logos or direct advertising. Use your creativity!
- 4. The Avenue Art committee retains full discretion to determine whether the artwork meets the standards set forth above.
- 5. Artists are fully responsible for repairing or replacing any elements of their work if it is damaged while in place.
- 6. Additional guidelines may be presented as the project progresses.
